ABOUT DR. JUSTICE RADHABINOD PAL



Dr. Justice Radhabinod Pal was a distinguished jurist, educator, and former Judge of the High Court at Calcutta. A notable alumnus of the Department of Law, University of Calcutta, he made significant contributions to both national and international legal discourse.

He was one of the three Asian judges and the only Indian called to adjudicate the Japanese war crime during the Second World War in the International Military Tribunal for the Far East (Tokyo Trials). His landmark dissenting opinion, delivered as the sole dissenting judge among the 11-member tribunal, reshaped perspectives on international law and remains a subject of extensive study and debate.

Beyond his contributions to international jurisprudence,

Dr. Justice Pal played a pivotal role in shaping India's tax laws, notably contributing to the Income Tax Act of 1922. He later served as a Professor of Law and subsequently as the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta, leaving an enduring impact on legal education in India.

In honour of his unparalleled legacy, the 1st Justice Radhabinod Pal Memorial National Moot Court Competition is being organized to celebrate his contributions to the legal field and inspire future generations of legal professionals.

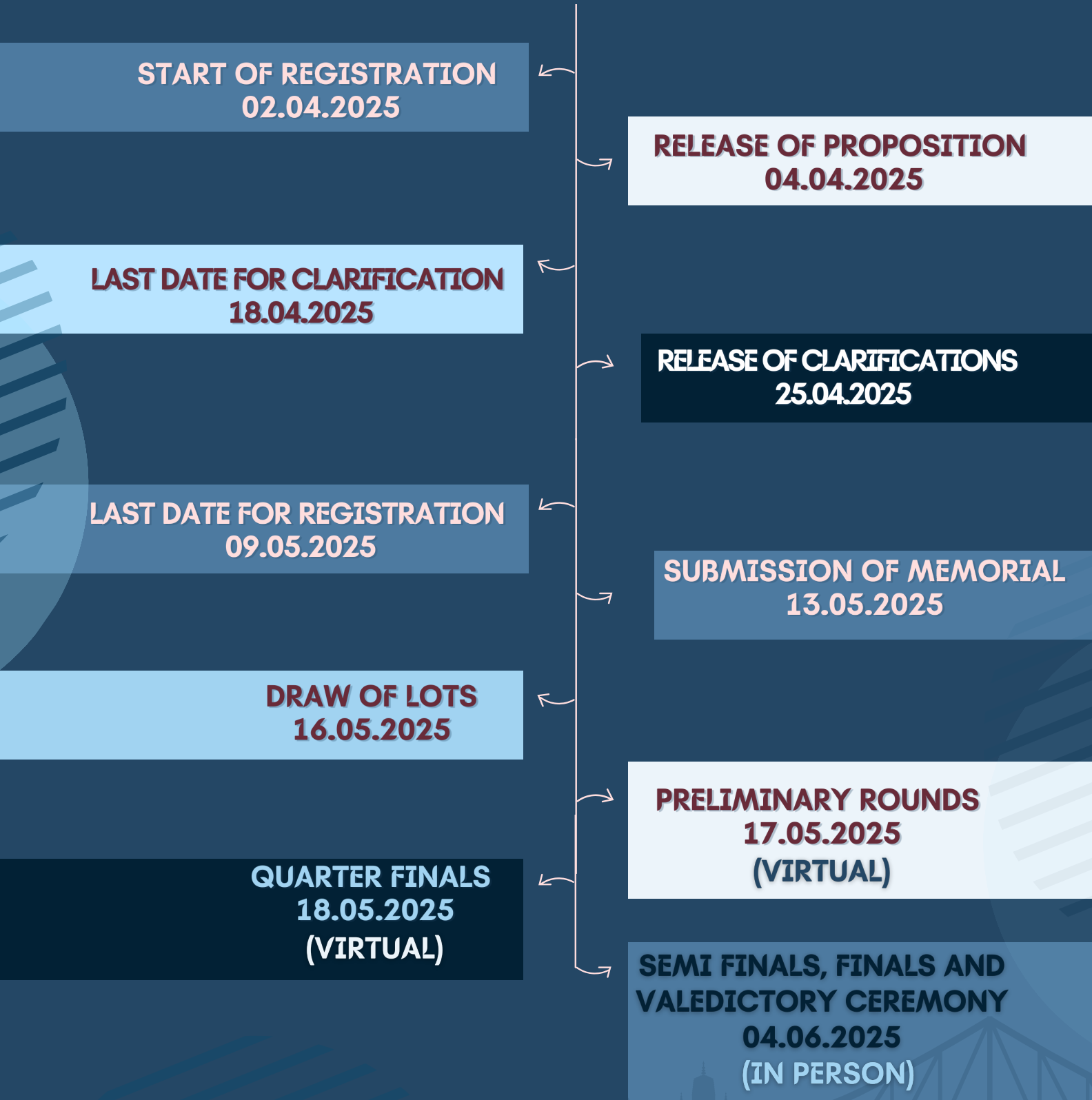
